Vacancy 1: Quality Control Technician

Reporting to the Quality Manager, among other duties, the selected individual will be responsible for:

- Ensuring that all quality control testing activities within Multigas Ltd are carried out in an effective and efficient manner;
- Ensuring that the relevant quality control testing results are documented as per procedures and all affected parties are notified using the respective channels;
- Ensuring that the any failing results are promptly reported, an investigation report immediately initiated, and support to Quality Management is provided;
- Ensuring that calibrations and verifications on analytical equipment are carried out within the specified time window, documented accordingly, and any issues with the equipment are promptly highlighted;
- Reporting of any deviations from procedures so that these can be investigated and the necessary corrective and preventive actions taken; and
- Providing support to Quality Management as might be requested from time to time

The ideal candidate will have an Advanced Level of Education (A level) in Chemistry, Biology or Physics. The selected candidate must be an organised and motivated individual, be computer literate, and willing to enhance their knowledge and gain the expertise required in the gas industry. Reporting to the Quality Manager, the duties of the selected individual include the below:

- As the company's RP, be responsible for the company's warehousing and distribution system of imported medicinal gases;
- As the company's Quality Officer, be responsible for:
 - o Ensuring that all Quality Management System (QMS) activities within Multigas Ltd are carried out in an effective and efficient manner;
 - o Ensuring that company systems, processes, procedures, and documentation are compliant with the relevant local and international regulatory and legislative quality frameworks;
 - o Write, review, and authorise specifications, sampling instructions, test methods, and other quality procedures and documents (including risk assessments) as necessary;

o Perform product analysis and equipment calibrations and qualifications as and when required and document results;

o Laboratory consumables stock management; and o Initiate and participate in quality investigations.

The ideal candidate will be a Pharmacist by profession and willing to achieve QP status for Medicinal gases. Candidates who hold a tertiary level of education in a science subject (qualification in Chemistry and/or Biology) will also be considered.
